The policies of *McMillan Woods Worldwide* are primarily determined by the International Executive Committee, which is made up of elected representatives from the six geographical areas or continents. All matters fundamentally affecting the association, are discussed at general meetings and Annual General Meetings, and are subject to the approval or rejection of the members.

Members from every country are expected to be actively involved in the activities of the association namely:

- Be able to provide the highest quality work, according to local and national conditions;
- Knowledgeable on all aspects of their home country's profession, commerce, politics and economy;
- Capable of dealing with clients currently or potentially involved in international businesses;
- Able to respond promptly to inquiries from fellow *McMillan Woods Worldwide* members or requests for information.



All members must exercise the following duties, due care and responsibilities:

- Refer any of the clients wishing to do business in a country in which *McMillan Woods Worldwide* firms are represented to the local member, provided that the local member is capable of providing the services required and that the client has not stipulated for another firm to be used;
- Pay all their association fees promptly and also pay any service fees due to other members promptly within the agreements with *McMillan Woods Worldwide* and their respective regional members; and
- All potential members to be admitted into the association must undergo a Quality Control Review (QCR) procedure, which will be carried out by an appointed representative(s) from *McMillan Woods Worldwide*, before the said firm is being invited to join the *McMillan Woods Worldwide* family.

- To assist members with the provision of the best professional services to their clients worldwide, through mutual assistance and invaluable support;
- To develop a better understanding of the profession and to foster a closer business relationship and friendship between members worldwide;
